1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to determine the process and criteria by which Carlile Swimming Team members can apply for and be awarded Life Membership of the Carlile Swimming Team.

2. Policy

2.1 Admission process

- The Company may, from among persons who have provided long and meritorious service with the Company, appoint Life Members in recognition of their efforts in furthering the interests of the Company.
- A Life Member may only be elected by Special Resolution at an Annual General Meeting.
- Nominations for life membership must be submitted to the Company and must be received by the Company secretary one hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the relevant Annual General Meeting.
- Nominations for life membership shall be examined by the Board. After reviewing the nomination and completing any relevant enquiries, the Board shall

make a recommendation to the Annual General Meeting in relation to the nomination.

- Upon life membership being conferred, the person's details shall be entered upon the register. A person shall become a Life Member from the time their life membership is formally announced.

2.2 Admission criteria

Applications for Life Membership may be submitted on behalf of persons who qualify based upon the following criteria:

- Members who have provided long and continuous service to the sport of swimming
- Provided meritorious service to the company
- Make an application in accordance with Clause 5.3 of the company constitution.
